All money raised this year is going to Anchor Ministries who provide local counselling services.

Across the Parish

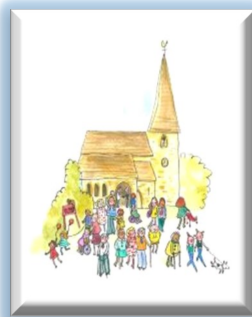
